Lead Case Mgmt initial visit; 15 minute increment (note each 15 min = 1 unit)	T1016 UA = \$12.50 per unit
Lead blood draw	36415 UA = \$3.00
Completion of Lead Risk Survey	99499 UA = \$3.00
Lead, qualitative (to be billed only when performing in office)	83655 TC = \$18.00
Minimal office visit, physician supervision not required	99211 = \$12.55 adult 99211 EP = \$15.00 under 21
<p>Have a child that needs an Environmental Risk Assessment for Lead?</p> <p>Call your Local City/County Public Health Agency or the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services at 1-866-628-9891.</p> <p>The Missouri Public Health System provides lead risk assessments to detect the hazardous sources of lead exposure in children's homes. The service is provided <u>free of charge</u> for all children under the age of six who have confirmed blood lead levels of 20 ug/dl or greater, or two confirmed blood lead levels of 15 ub/dl or greater that are taken at least 3 months apart. This service is not reimbursable by Children's Mercy Family Health Partners. Environmental Lead Inspections will be reimbursed by Medicaid if done by a licensed Missouri Lead Risk Assessor and enrolled as a Medicaid provider.</p>
